This past month Lisa Hurley from the Aging and disability resource center came and did a presentation at our volunteer training we held. The topic was "Effective Communication Strategies." We discussed the many causes of communication changes, important strategies, and methods to better connect with our program participants. Some of the changes we notice with our participants and their abilities to communicate are



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difficulties finding the right words, taking longer to speak or respond, withdrawing from conversations, struggling with decision making, using familiar words repeatedly, easily losing their train of thought, speaking less frequently, and communicating through a behavior rather than words.

At the training we learned to keep our sentences straightforward, to leave plenty of time, for conservations, approach from the front and use first names. We were also

reminded of our body language of which accounts for 55% of all communication, 38% is in tone, and only 7% in words. Lisa did a great job teaching us how memory loss affects one's perception causes language changes, and that all behavior is a form of communication. Our role is to listen, investigate the cause and meet their needs! Our volunteers here at The Gathering Place already do a great job, but it always nice to be reminded of and to be able to better serve our participants with memory loss.
